This information will also feed into both our Shops & Buildings Project and our Census & Directories Project (see separate sheets).

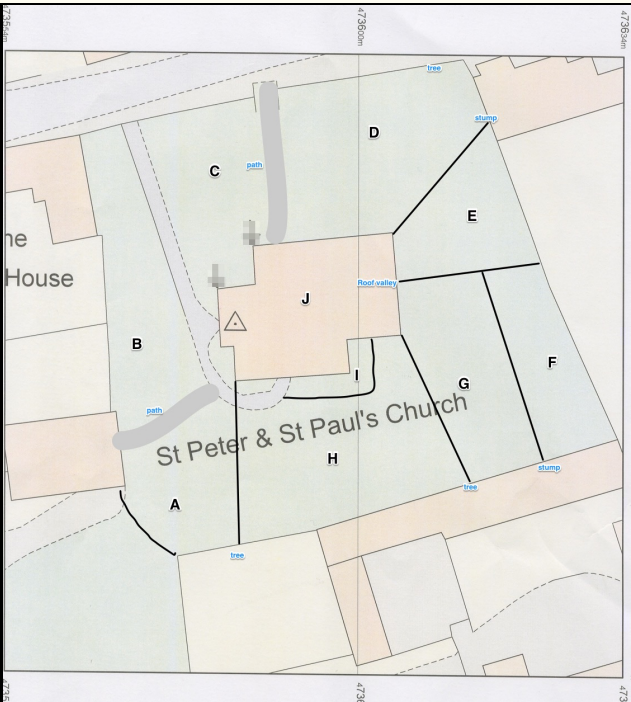
No specific deadline, but we would like to get it done before the autumn.

Southern Edge: To the Memory ROBERT GAMSON of Gringley Grange Died Feb VII (7th)  
Eastern Edge: MDCCCLIV (1854) aged LXXIV years (74)  
Northern Edge: Also of JANE his Wife Died January XXIII (23rd) MDCCCXLIX (1849)  
Western Edge: Aged LXIX Years (69)



ADDITIONAL NOTES

Robert was a prominent farmer indeed living at Gringley Grange (290 acres in 1851). In the 1841 Census he is shown as living with Ann aged 55, either a first wife or sister, with younger William and Martha both aged 25.
