The Census & Directories Project (see separate sheet) feeds directly into this.

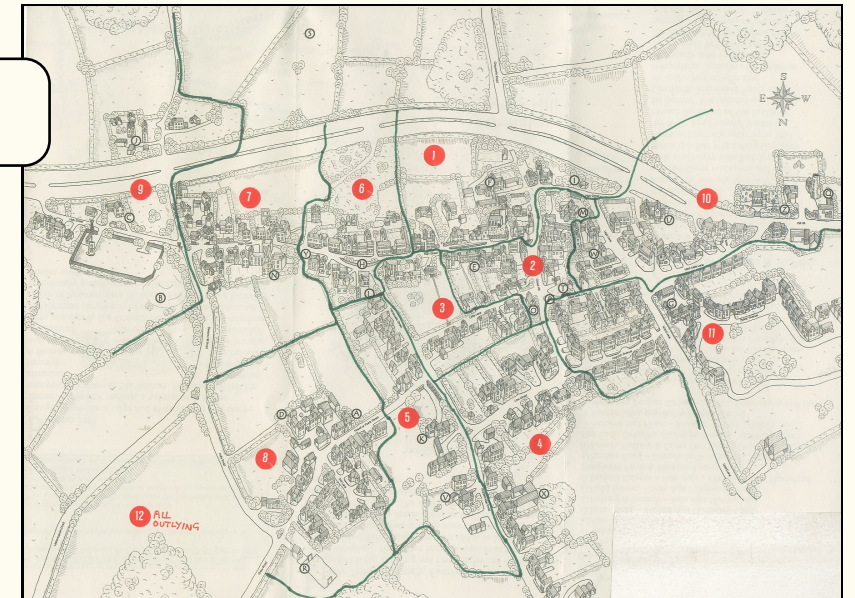
How can I help?
